



# Window Safety

- 1 Always supervise young children, particularly in rooms with open windows.
- 2 Install window guards or stops that meet ASTM standards to prevent windows from opening more than 4 inches.
- 3 Move furniture, including beds, chairs, and bookshelves away from windows to prevent climbing.
- 4 Keep windows closed and locked. If you must open them, use the top opening.
- 5 Do not rely on window screens — they are designed to keep insects out, not children in.
